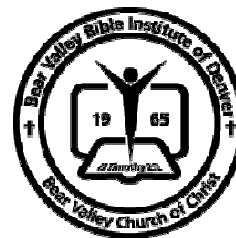
## Note from Lyle Sinkey

## Involvement Ministry with Ted Edwards



"Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." ~ Matthew 28:18-20

I am grateful to serve with a church family who believes in the Great Commission that our Lord gave us! One of the annual blessings at SH that I look forward to is Missions Sunday and it's coming up in 2 weeks. This year we are fortunate to have Bill and Marie-Claire McDonough as our guest presenters for **Missions Sunday**. Many of you know this couple but for those of you who don't, the following will help you get to know Bill and Marie-Claire.

Following 20 years of missionary service in Europe, Bill McDonough co-founded Partners in Progress with Dr. A. J. Thompson in 1980 and serves as the director. PIP is a church planting/humanitarian aid ministry that has been active in fifty-eight nations and is overseen by the eldership of the Windsong Church of Christ. PIP has been instrumental focusing attention on and assisting persecuted Christians in Cuba, Laos, Vietnam and Myanmar.

PIP organizes short-term medical missions around the world to provide health care professionals with opportunities to serve the people of developing nations. They currently conduct these on four continents; they also offer a free clinic in downtown Little Rock. PIP is in the process of launching a new clinical boat that will operate on the Mekong River in Southeast Asia, providing health care to thousands of the 15 million residents who have none.

As a young woman Marie-Claire moved from her home in Northern France to Southern France to be a part of a self-supporting church planting team that worked in Naute, France. Later she was sent to Romania by French and Swiss churches to work with French speaking students who were studying the Bible via correspondence and was involved in establishing an orphanage and children's works. In 1995 she married Bill McDonough and has since that time been tirelessly involved in organizing English Bible study programs, nutrition and back to school programs for more than 1400 children in Cambodia and now in Myanmar where they moved last year. We look forward to our time together with the McDonough's on Missions Sunday, February 7<sup>th</sup>.
